



## 2022 ProMX National Rider Number Allocation Process

V2 (1<sup>st</sup> November 2022)

The following information outlines the process on how to apply for your preferred race number when competing in the 2022 ProMX Championship. In 2022 a competitor may register a one, two or three-digit number.

- The rider must have met the minimum requirements as listed in the MoMS during 2021 to reserve their number for 2022
- A rider may only register one number for 2022
- If the rider does not meet the minimum requirements as listed in the MoMS in 2022, their number may be forfeited for 2023
- All number plates on all machines **MUST** comply with the GCR 's and must not contain any decals or advertising other than the required decal available at [www.auspromx.com.au](http://www.auspromx.com.au)

If any of the following apply to a competitor, they will need to complete a Rider Number Application:

- The rider is new to the Championship;
- The rider was inactive in 2021
- The rider did not meet the minimum requirements as listed in the MoMS during the Championship in 2021;
- The rider holds an existing number from 2021 but is electing to change the number for 2022;
- A rider who finished 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in their respective class in the 2021 Championship and would like to run their finishing number for 2022 (rider must be remaining in the same class) The recipient of this number can choose not to use Number 1, 2 or 3, but instead use their preferred number. The Number 1, 2 or 3 plate or that competitor's preferred number will not be used by any other competitor in that class.

It is the riders responsibility to confirm their number was carried over from 2021, please check the 2022 ProMX Rider Number Allocation document to ensure this has been completed.

A competitor may elect to request to use #1, 2 or 3 based on his/her 2021 MX Championship result. If a rider chooses to use the 1, 2 or 3, that riders existing preferred number will be reserved for one (1) year, from which they can return to that number.

### Application Process:

1. Download the 2022 Riders Number Allocation document from [www.auspromx.com.au](http://www.auspromx.com.au)
2. Determine if a Rider Number Application is required
3. Identify three (3) desired numbers in order of preference for appropriate class of competition
4. Complete the 2022 ProMX Rider Number Application [www.auspromx.com.au](http://www.auspromx.com.au)
5. List your three preferences and return as instructed
