



2024 ProMX National Rider Number Allocation Process

V1 (1st November 2023)

The following information outlines the process on how to apply for your preferred race number when competing in the 2024 ProMX Championship. In 2024, a competitor may register a one, two or three-digit number.

- To retain a career number, the rider must have met the minimum requirements as listed in the MoMS during 2023 to reserve their number for 2024*.
- A rider may only register one number for 2024.
- If the rider does not compete in a minimum of four rounds in 2023, their number may be forfeited for 2024, and they will need to reapply for it.
- All number plates on all machines **MUST** comply with the GCR's and must not contain any decals or advertising other than the required decal available at www.auspromx.com.au/competitor-information/

If any of the following apply to a competitor, they will need to complete a Rider Number Application:

- If the rider is new to the Championship.
- If the rider was inactive in 2023.
- If the rider did not meet the minimum requirements as listed in the MoMS during the Championship in 2023.
- If the rider holds an existing number from 2023 but is electing to change the number for 2024.
- If a rider who finished 1st, 2nd or 3rd in their respective class in the 2023 Championship, and would like to run their finishing number for 2024 (rider must be remaining in the same class).
The recipient of the 1st, 2nd or 3rd placing can choose not to use number 1, 2 or 3, and can continue to use their preferred number as normal. If unused, the number 1, 2 or 3 plate, or that competitor's preferred number will not be used by any other competitor in that class. Further, their preferred number will be reserved for them for one (1) year.

It is the rider's responsibility to confirm their number was carried over from 2023.

Please check the 2024 ProMX Rider Number Allocation document to ensure this has been completed.

Application Process:

1. Download the 2024 Riders Number Allocation document from the Competitor Information page at www.auspromx.com.au
2. Determine if a Rider Number Application is required.
3. Identify three (3) desired numbers in order of preference for appropriate class of competition. (Please do not use letters)
4. Complete the 2024 ProMX Rider Number Application and return to info@auspromx.com.au

*subject to exemptions on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of MA
